FAMILY DISCIPLESHIP TIME

B is for Brave: Doing Whatever God Asks Without Fear

Objective: Students learned that doing whatever God asks us to do without fear makes us more like Jesus.

Bible Verse: Joshua 1:9 *“Be strong and brave, don’t be afraid, because God will be with you wherever you go.”* (ERV)

Bible Story: Jesus is Brave and Calms the Storm (Matthew 8:23-27)

Action Steps:

- 1. Bible Time:** As a family, read *Jesus is Brave and Calms the Storm*, and talk about how Jesus showed a brave heart.
- 2. Scripture Memory:** Practice singing or reciting the memory verse each day as a family.
- 3. Practice:** Talk about times when your children might be scared, for example talking to someone new, going to the doctor/dentist, or seeing a bug. If something comes up this week that your children are a little nervous about, sing the Bible verse with them and encourage them to be brave and conquer their fear, because God is with them and will help them! **Place stickers or checkmarks next to BRAVE on your Character Trait Sticker Chart every time you catch your children displaying a brave heart.**
- 4. Model:** Be open with your kids about times you are scared and how you pray and ask God to help you through those times. Children will pick up character traits more easily when they see a good model from parents! 😊
